## Bickleton Rodeo and Carousel Rally (all dry camping)

**Thursday, June 8,** - Meet at Legends Casino, 580 Fort Rd., Toppenish, WA. Arrive all day. .parking in Aisle F (at the back of the parking lot). No charge. Gas, Safeway, casino and other shopping are all on Fort Rd (called 1st St. in town) not more than a mile away. Dinner is an all-you-can-eat buffet - seafood,prime rib, etc. \$30.00.

**Friday, June 9,**-breakfast on your own-Travel to Bickleton, (we'll have a small map to give you) then Cleveland (3.5 miles west) to park in a lovely pine tree-lined meadow. This is about an hour from Toppenish. We'd like to arrive and get parked by 10:30 so we can claim our spots, then use a couple of rigs to ferry back to Bickleton to see their really great museum, because the museum closes for the rodeo as well as about everything else in town except the post office, NO GAS. There is a community Potluck at the Park at 5 o'clock-everyone welcome, and then a dance and beer garden at 8 o'clock. So you get a little break in the afternoon (lunch or snacks on your own), then let's party!

**Saturday, June 10** Cowboy Memorial and Parade at 10 :00. Rodeo at 1:00. Food vendors (American (hamburgers, hot dogs, fries, etc.) and Mexican. They make a great breakfast, too (pancakes, biscuits and gravy, eggs, ham, toast etc.) Yes, coffee. Adult Dance 8:00, Age- Over 25 . Yep, more partying.

We're trying to. arrange a time to see the Whoop and Holler Car museum...if we can fit it in. Some-time during your stay, ride the carousel. It's over 100 years old - refurbished by local people, and set up on the grounds to be rode only during rodeo weekend.

**Sunday June 11th,** 9:30 Cowboy church, 1:00 Rodeo. Food will be on your own or the food vendors. Clean up your spot, stay or head on out - maybe back to Toppenish to see their murals, train museum, buy gas- probably the cheapest in WA, dump, or visit casino again - your choice.
